Tuesday 4th June 2019:

Check in opens at 1300hrs where you can meet your fellow participants along with members of the event team and VIPs at the site of Tarrant Rushton Airfield.

Here you will check in for the event, can enjoy a hot snack and a brew as well as attend the all-important safety and event briefing.

The challenge will commence at 1800hrs with a lap of the historic perimeter road of the airfield before heading along the beautiful Dorset countryside, through the New Forest, Southampton, Fareham and finally to the ferry terminal in Portsmouth

Wednesday 5th June 2019:

By the evening, you will have made it to Portsmouth and will be checking in ready to board the Mont St Michel ferry which sails at 2200hrs for Caen (Ouistreham).

Thursday 6th June 2019:

The ferry is due to arrive in Ouistreham at 0645hrs. Once disembarked and cleared customs, you will have plenty of time to gather your thoughts and grab a coffee and something for breakfast at the ferry terminal. The group will set off for the next leg of the adventure at around 1000hrs.
